You can bring a power bank on your flight, as long as it's in your carry-on and meets capacity rules. Whether you're flying across the country or halfway around the world, choosing the ...

Power banks **MUST** be in carry-on luggage (prohibited in checked bags). Capacity limits apply: typically 100Wh (27,000mAh) without approval, 100-160Wh with airline approval.
