The new MTU units will add a total storage capacity of 4,268 kWh and a power output of 4,800 kVA. Along with lithium ion batteries, the MTU EnergyPack houses an electronic control unit, transformers, ...

It typically includes solar panels, wind turbines, energy storage systems (such as batteries), and control systems. Together, these components work to provide a stable power supply, ...

To do this they are constructing solar arrays backed up with small amounts of Li-ion battery storage which they believe will overcome the solar intermittency problem.

Around 4.2 MWh of energy storage capacity will be connected to a solar and diesel micro-grid on Rarotonga, the largest of the islands in the South Pacific nation.
