

# Georgia energy storage sodium ion battery base project

Georgia is set to implement its first electricity storage battery system, with the initial phase scheduled for 2025 and the project expected to continue through the end of 2028.

This project focuses on improving the performance, lifespan, and safety of sodium-ion batteries, making them suitable for large-scale energy storage applications.
