The Republic of Armenia has one nuclear power unit (Unit 2, Armenian NPP (ANPP), also sometimes referred to as Metsamor NPP) in operation which provides about one third of domestic electricity, ...

Armenia has relied heavily on nuclear power since 1976. It has one reactor in operation and the government plans to build another.
