

2. Place the front cover in the open position and fasten to the top of the left and right legs using the Chicago screws. 4. Align cover over inverter and mark the 4 corner mounting points with a marker. 6. ...

Remove the cover **NOTE** The inverter cover assembly is too big for one person to handle safely. SolarEdge recommends that two people remove and handle the cover assembly. Using a ...

The whole inverter case is a single piece screwed on the heat sink, there's a seal for IP68 rating. It opens easily, here's the connector panel, normally at the bottom of the inverter, seen ...

If not already removed, remove the inverter cover: Open the inverter cover's six Allen screws and carefully pull the cover horizontally before lowering it.

To prevent water or dust entering the interior of the inverter, clean and dry the lid prior to removal. On the Sunny Island, remove all screws of the lower enclosure lid using an Allen key (AF 5) and remove ...

Open the inverter cover's six Allen screws and carefully move the cover vertically before lowering it. **CAUTION:** When removing the cover, make sure not to damage internal components.
